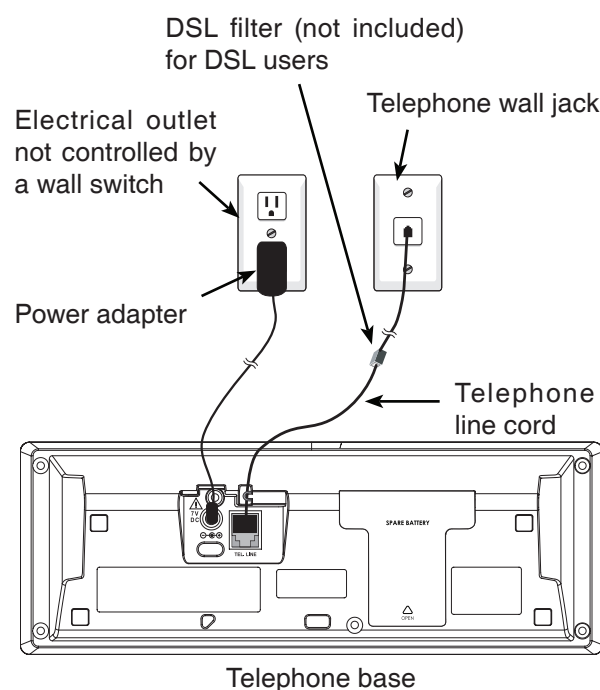


Quick start guide for model LS5145

Install the telephone base

Install the telephone base as shown below.



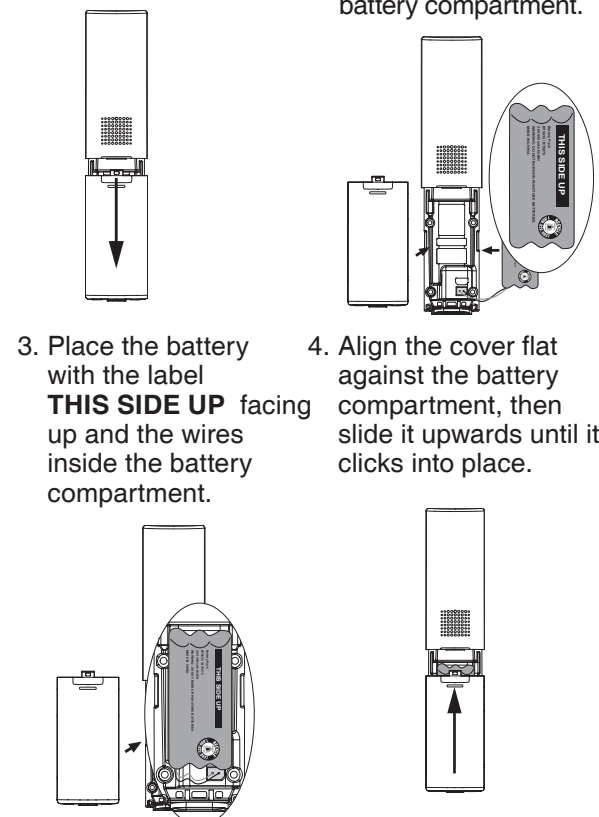
NOTES:

1. Use only the power adapter and battery supplied with your VTech telephone.
2. For complete feature instructions, please refer to your user's manual.

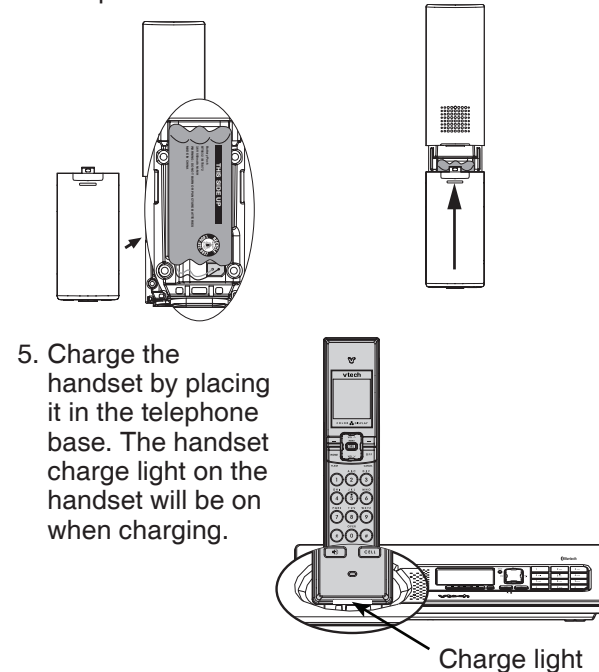
Battery installation and charging

Install the battery as shown below. For optimal performance, charge the handset battery for at least 16 hours before use.

1. Press the tab and slide the battery compartment cover downwards.
2. Insert the plug as indicated. Make sure it is plugged securely and matches the color-coded label inside the battery compartment.



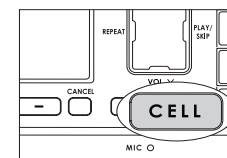
3. Place the battery with the label **THIS SIDE UP** facing up and the wires inside the battery compartment.
4. Align the cover flat against the battery compartment, then slide it upwards until it clicks into place.



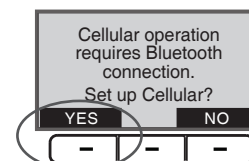
Pairing your first Bluetooth cell phone

To pair and connect your first Bluetooth cell phone:

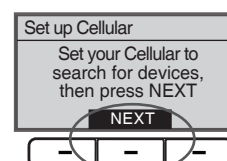
1. Press **CELL** on the telephone base.



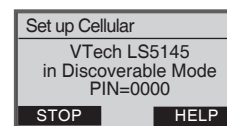
2. Press the **YES** softkey.



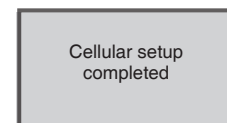
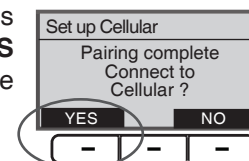
3. Set your cell phone to search for or add new devices, then press the **NEXT** softkey.



4. Once your cell phone finds your **VTech LS5145**, select it and then enter the PIN **0000** on your cell phone.



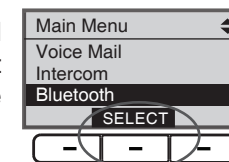
5. When the pairing is completed, press the **YES** softkey on the telephone base.



Pairing your first Bluetooth headset

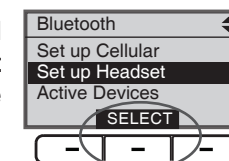
To pair and connect your first Bluetooth headset:

1. Press the **MENU** softkey on the telephone base.

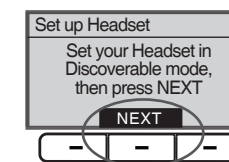


2. Press the **UP** and **DOWN** NavKeys to highlight **Bluetooth**, then press the **SELECT** softkey.

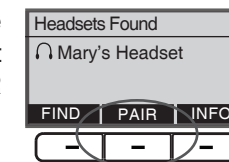
3. Press the **UP** and **DOWN** NavKeys to highlight **Set up Headset**, then press the **SELECT** softkey.



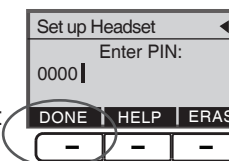
4. Set your headset in discoverable mode, then press the **NEXT** softkey.



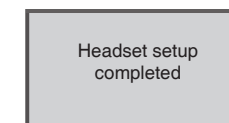
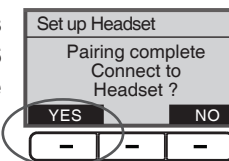
5. Once the telephone base finds your headset, select it and then press the **PAIR** softkey.



6. Enter your headset's PIN on the telephone base, then press the **DONE** softkey. The default PIN for most headsets is **0000**.




7. When the pairing is completed, press the **YES** softkey on the telephone base.




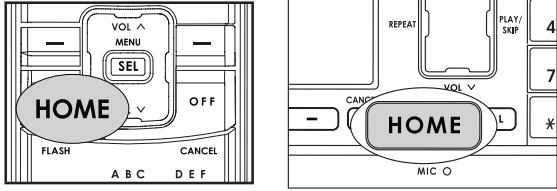
Making, receiving and ending calls

To make a **HOME** call:

- Dial the telephone number, then press **HOME/FLASH** or  on the handset, or **HOME** on the telephone base.

To receive a **HOME** call:

- Press **HOME/FLASH** or  on the handset or **HOME** on the telephone base.




If you have a Bluetooth headset connected, press the call button on your headset to receive **HOME** calls.

To make a **CELL** call:

- Dial the telephone number, then press **CELL** on the handset or telephone base.

To receive a **CELL** call:

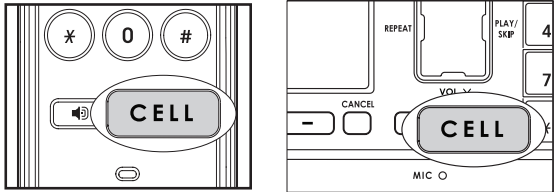
- Press **CELL** or  on the handset or **CELL** on the telephone base.

To end a **HOME** or **CELL** call on the handset:

- Press the **OFF/CANCEL** or return the handset in the telephone base or charger.

To end a call on the telephone base:

- Press **HOME** for a **HOME** call.
- Press **CELL** for a **CELL** call.



Using your answering system

To play answering system messages:

Using a handset

1. Press **MENU/SELECT** when the handset is in idle mode.
2. Press the **UP** and **DOWN** NavKeys to select **Messages**, then press **MENU/SELECT** to enter the **Messages** menu.
3. While in the **Messages** menu:

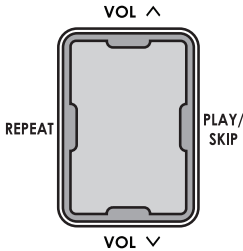


- Press the **PLAY** softkey to play messages.
- Press the **RIGHT** NavKey to skip to the next message.
- Press the **LEFT** NavKey to repeat the message currently playing. Press twice to listen to the previous message.
- Press the **STOP** softkey to stop the playback.
- Press the **DELETE** softkey to delete the message currently being played.

Using the telephone base

When you have a message on the telephone base:

- Press **PLAY/SKIP** to play messages.
- Press **PLAY/SKIP** again to skip to the next message.
- Press **REPEAT** to repeat the message currently playing. Press **REPEAT** twice to listen to the previous message.
- Press the **STOP** softkey to stop the playback.
- Press the **DELETE** softkey to delete the message currently being played.



More about Bluetooth

You can make and receive calls using the **HOME** and **CELL** lines. The **HOME** line is your conventional telephone land line. The **CELL** line is the communications service provided through your Bluetooth enabled cell phone.

Before using your Bluetooth device(s) with the telephone base, make sure that:

- Your cell phone and/or headset devices are not connected to any other Bluetooth device(s) and the Bluetooth wireless function is on.
- Your device is connected to the telephone base and on the **Active Devices** list.

If you experience difficulty using your Bluetooth cell phone:

1. Make sure that your Bluetooth cell phone is working properly. See your Bluetooth device(s) user's manual for more information.
2. Delete the **VTech LS5145** device on your cell phone, then delete your cell phone on the **Pair Devices** list.
3. Repeat the pairing process in **Pair your first Bluetooth cell phone** in this Quick start guide.
