
## TEST THE LOCATION FOR THE BABY UNIT

If you plan to install your baby unit in a designated location, and use your home Wi-Fi network to connect your video monitor, you need to test which of your selected monitoring areas within the house have good Wi-Fi signal strength. After you have powered on your parent unit, you can use your parent unit's Wi-Fi signal strength indicator to assist in checking.
